1 ORDINANCE NO. 110263 2 An Ordinance amending the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan: by amending the Future Land Use Element Map Series, the 3 Transportation Mobility Element Map Series, and the Concurrency 4 5 Management Element Map Series; by incorporating and adding 6 additional parcels of land that were annexed into the City to 7 Transportation Concurrency Exception Area maps of said Series, as 8 more specifically described in this ordinance; including Parcel No. 07874-001-001, located in the vicinity of the 1500 block of NE 53rd 9 Avenue, north side to Zone A, and including the western portion of 10 Parcel No. 07871-000-000 to Zone B; including Parcel Nos. 06654-003-11 000 and 06654-003-001, located in the vicinity of the 7200-7300 blocks of 12 NW 4th Boulevard, east of NW 75th Street to Zone D; providing 13 directions to the City Manager; providing a severability clause: 14 15 providing a repealing clause and providing an effective date. 16 17 WHEREAS, publication of notice of a public hearing was given that the Future Land Use Element Map Series, the Transportation Mobility Element Map Series, and the Concurrency 18 Management Element Map Series, be amended by adding four parcels of land and incorporating 19 20 them into certain Transportation Concurrency Exception Area (TCEA) Zones, as more specifically 21 described in this ordinance; and 22 WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made as required by law and a public hearing was held by the City Plan Board on April 28, 2011; and 23 24 WHEREAS, pursuant to law, an advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 25 inches long was placed in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this 26 proposed ordinance and of the public hearing to be held at the transmittal stage in the City Commission Meeting Room, First Floor, City Hall, in the City of Gainesville at least seven (7) 27 days after the day the first advertisement was published; and 28

1	WHEREAS, pursuant to law, after the public hearing at the transmittal stage, the City of
2	Gainesville transmitted copies of this proposed change to the Reviewing Agencies and any other
3	local government unit or state agency that requested same; and
4	WHEREAS, a second advertisement no less than two columns wide by 10 inches long
5	was placed in the aforesaid newspaper notifying the public of the second public hearing to be
6	held at the adoption stage at least five (5) days after the day the second advertisement was
7	published; and
8	WHEREAS, the public hearings were held pursuant to the published notices described
9	above at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were,
10	in fact, heard; and
11	WHEREAS, prior to adoption of this ordinance, the City Commission has considered
12	written comments, if any were received, concerning this plan amendment.
13	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
14	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
15	Section 1. The Future Land Use Element Map Series, Transportation Concurrency
16	Exception Area, of the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan is amended as shown on the map
17	attached hereto as Exhibit A-1:
18 19	See map attached hereto as Exhibit "A-1" and made a part hereof as if set forth in full.
20	Section 2. The Transportation Mobility Element Map Series, Transportation Concurrency
21	Exception Area, of the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan is amended as shown on the map
22	attached hereto as Exhibit A-2:
23 24	See map attached hereto as Exhibit "A-2" and made a part hereof as if set forth in full.

- Section 3. The Concurrency Management Element Map Series, Transportation
 Concurrency Exception Area, of the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan is amended as shown
 on the map attached hereto as Exhibit A-3:
- See map attached hereto as Exhibit "A-3" and made a part hereof as if set forth in full.
 - **Section 4.** The City Manager is authorized and directed to make the necessary changes in maps and other data in the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan, or element, or portion thereof in order to comply with this ordinance.
 - Section 5. Within 10 days of the transmittal (first) hearing, the City Manager is authorized and directed to transmit a comprehensive plan amendment package, including this ordinance, to the Reviewing Agencies and to any other local government unit or state agency that has filed a written request for same with the City. Within 10 days of the adoption (second) hearing, the City Manager is authorized and directed to transmit a comprehensive plan amendment package, including this ordinance, to the State Land Planning Agency and to any other Reviewing Agency, local government unit or state agency that filed written comments with the City.
 - **Section 6.** If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
 - **Section 7.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.
- Section 8. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage on second reading; however, the effective date of this plan amendment, if the amendment is not timely

- challenged, shall be 31 days after the State Land Planning Agency notifies the City that the plan
- 2 amendment package is complete in accordance with Chapter 163.3184, F.S. If timely challenged,
- 3 this amendment shall become effective on the date the State Land Planning Agency or the
- 4 Administration Commission enters a final order determining this adopted amendment to be in
- 5 compliance in accordance with Chapter 163.3184, F.S. No development orders, development
- 6 permits, or land uses dependent on this amendment may be issued or commenced before this plan
- 7 amendment has become effective.







Exhibit A-3: Concurrency Management Element TCEA Map
