13 14	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9-2(b) of the Code of Ordinances, the Clerk is to	
15	recommend a date for the next regular election to the City Commission at or before the	
16	first regular Commission meeting in May of each year;	
17	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9-2(b) of the Code of Ordinances the City	
18	Commission is to adopt an ordinance setting the date of the next regular election by July	
19	1 st of each year;	
20	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9-2(c) of the Code of Ordinances, the first	
21	Tuesday in March of the following year is automatically established as the election date if	
22	the City Commission fails to adopt an ordinance setting an election date by July 1st of any	
23	year;	
24	WHEREAS, one of the factors the City Commission is to consider in setting the	
25	date of the next election is the date of any statewide election occurring at or about the	
26	same time;	
27	WHEREAS, there is a bill pending in the House and Senate proposing that the	
28	date of the Florida Presidential Preference Primary be moved to one week after the New	
29	Hampshire Primary, which, if New Hampshire's Primary stays on the same schedule	

- would place Florida's Presidential Preference Primary Election on January 29, 2008;
- 2 **WHEREAS,** by mid-May 2007 it will be known what action will be taken by the
- 3 House and Senate as to the setting of a date for the Florida Presidential Preference
- 4 Primary;
- 5 **WHEREAS**, suspending the scheduling date contained in Sections 9-2(b) and (c)
- 6 would allow the City Commission to consider the date of the Florida Presidential
- 7 Preference Primary in scheduling the City Commission regular election;
- 8 WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a
- 9 newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a
- Public Hearing in the Auditorium of City Hall in the City of Gainesville; and
- WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held pursuant to the published notice
- described at which hearing the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be
- and were, in fact, heard;

- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION
- 15 **OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:**
- Section 1. The scheduling date in Sections 9-2(b) and (c) Gainesville Code of
- Ordinances are hereby temporarily suspended for purposes of the City Commission
- elections to be held in 2008. The City Commission intends to schedule the 2008 elections
- soon after the Florida Legislature sets the date for the 2008 Florida Presidential
- 20 Preference Primary election.
- 21 Section 2. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be
- invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall
- in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

1	Section 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the		
2	extent of such conflict hereby repealed.		
3	Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final		
4	adoption.
