Workshop: Trees and Hurricanes

Gainesville learned a lot from tropical storms (e.g., "Frances" and "Jeanne") in terms of tree debris and removal. Gainesville's tree canopy is high (50% - 60% coverage) compared to most communities. It might be assumed that tree damage in Gainesville would have been less with fewer trees, but the reverse proved true. The heavy tree canopy forced the winds upward, away from roofs. Homes that had strong trees in their yards were protected by the trees. The City of Gainesville through the CBB needs to provide education on how to evaluate the condition of trees in relation to storms.

The City Beautification Board will hold a workshop at the Thomas Center, following the same format as the very successful workshop on medians and roundabouts conducted in 2007. It will work with the Nature Operations Division on a program to identify tree hazards, best species and sites for (re)planting, and how to work with commercial tree service providers after storms.
