Explanation: Commissioner Scherwin Henry brought this issue forward at the October 7, 2010, City Commission Meeting during Commission Comment, and the City Commission referred this matter to the Equal Opportunity Committee. At that meeting Commissioner Henry requested that staff present a report on local and minority business program in the City of Memphis, Tennessee.

> At its December 6 meeting, the EOC heard a brief presentation from the EO Director on local and minority business program in the City of Memphis, Tennessee, and discussed the City's own SBE and SBPP programs. The Committee voted unanimously to have staff 1) survey three (GRU Station, Public Works, and CRA) recent projects; 2) see what local contractors are available to see who bid and who won bid; 3) see why those who bid did not win and see why those who did not bid, didn't; and 3) report back to the Committee in March.

RECOMMENDATION

The Equal Opportunity Committee: 1) hear a report from the EO Director on three of the City's recent building projects detailing the usage of local small businesses in the initial phase of the process as well as the construction manager's efforts in this area; 2) discuss report findings; and 3) take appropriate action.
