14	Hearing that the text of the Land Development Code of the City of Gainesville, Florida, be

16	WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made as required by law and a Public			
17	Hearing was then held by the City Plan Board on September 21, 2006; and			
18	WHEREAS, the City Plan Board heard and approved this petition on September 21,			
19	2006; and			
20	WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper			
21	of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a Public Hearing in			
22	the Auditorium of City Hall in the City of Gainesville; and			
23	WHEREAS, the Public Hearings were held pursuant to the published notice described at			
24	which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact,

26	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE			
27	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:			
28	Section 1. Subsection 30-53(d), Table 3, City of Gainesville Land Development Code, is			
29	amended to read as follows:			

Sec. 30-53. *Multiple-family medium density residential districts (RMF-6, RMF-7 and RMF-8).*

³To be granted a special use permit for four or five stories in the RMF-6, RMF-7 or RMF-8 districts excluding the College Park, University Heights and Traditional City Special Area Plans (where up to 5 stories is allowed by right), the applicant must demonstrate that:

a. The property is not adjacent to property with a single-family residential land use category (this restriction does not apply in College Park, University Heights and Traditional City); and

b. To promote a more vital, interesting sidewalk environment for pedestrians near taller buildings, reduce the perception of a massive scale delivered by larger buildings with monotonously blank walls, and increase security through citizen surveillance, a minimum of 25% non-reflective, transparent glazing is provided on the front and side building walls at pedestrian level (and this glazed area shall be between three feet and eight feet above grade) on the first floor.

c. First story is at least 10 feet floor to ceiling for all buildings.

- **Section 2.** It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions.
- Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
