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- ◆ February 2011 Record of Decision (ROD) released that outlines required cleanup of soils, sediment, groundwater for both Koppers and Cabot Carbon
- ◆ ROD was developed with significant input from the Local Intergovernmental Team (LIT) including City of Gainesville, GRU, ACEPD reps.

# Recent History

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
- ◆ July 2013, Federal Court approves Beazer East/EPA consent decree for remedial design/action at Koppers
- ◆ Cabot Carbon conducts sediment removal of 119 tons of contaminated sediments from Hogtown and Springstead Creeks

# Recent History

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- ◆ Beazer East completes offsite soil removal and replacement for
- ◆ 100% participation!
- ◆ City participation through GRU representatives assisted in keeping information flowing and addressing issues associated with remediation

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- ◆ In-situ geochemical stabilizations (ISGS) injections at Koppers Process area through September 2015.
- ◆ Upper Floridan well installation at Cabot Carbon
- ◆ Remedial design data collection for vertical barrier wall installation at Koppers
- ◆ December 2015 LIT technical working group meeting to consider draft focused feasibility study Cabot Hawthorn treatment

# Next Up

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- ◆ December 2015 Cabot Carbon samples remaining areas of Hogtown and Springstead Creeks
- ◆ Vertical barrier wall installation in 2016 at Koppers
