

## The City of Alachua Factual Summary of Agreement


- Extends a long standing relationship with an important neighbor & customer for another four years
- The transmission rate is expected to be 2.36/k—month, which translates to 265,000/year in revenue assuming a 100 peak demand each year
- Net Present Value of the contract (2022-2026) is expected to yield ~\$1.6M in transmission revenues
- Agreement Primary Term length is four years with option of successive two year term extensions
- City of Alachua Commission executed its portion of the Agreement on 2/28/22
- At the end of Agreement, City of Alachua has the option to disconnect its substation from GRU's transmission network at its own cost
- GRU is seeking to continue the Operations & Maintenance Contract with the City of Alachua to span
  the entire four year term

## Recommendations

- 1. Authorize the General Manager or his designee to execute the Agreement between the City of Gainesville, d/b/a GRU, and the City of Alachua for the delivery of energy and capacity by the City of Alachua to GRU through the transmission system of GRU, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality
- 2. Authorize the General Manager or his designee to execute such other documents as may be necessary or desirable to proceed with the transaction authorized above, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality, and to take such other actions as may be necessary or advisable to proceed with such transaction in accordance with this City Commission authorization
