WHEREAS, the third Monday in January is recognized as a National Holiday in memory and in recognition of the life, deeds and principles espoused by Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. devoted his life to the fight for the full rights of citizenship for the poor and the racially oppressed, all the while exhibiting courage and moral presence; and

WHEREAS, Dr. King's quest cost him his life in Memphis, Tennessee on April 4, 1968; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville will honor Dr. King's deeds and dreams by holding several special events during King Celebration 2014, January 12-21, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Highway 441 in Alachua County has been renamed the Martin Luther King, Jr. Highway by House Bill 230, Chapter Law 88-419; and

WHEREAS, The Martin Luther King Jr., Commission will be celebrating its 30th Year Anniversary of honoring the legacy of Dr. King and working for Civil Rights in Gainesville and Alachua County.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edward B. Braddy, by the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Gainesville, do hereby proclaim January 12-21, 2014 as

in the City of Gainesville and invite all our citizens to join me in participating in the many activities which will be held in honor of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.
