

RESOLUTION NO. 100128

PASSED July 1, 2010

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER FOR UTILITIES OR HIS DESIGNEES TO APPROVE DEEDS, AGREEMENTS, LICENSES AND PERMITS WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR SERVICES, FACILITIES OR USAGE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville, Florida, (City) through its utility Gainesville Regional Utilities (GRU) routinely enters into various deeds, easements, agreements, licenses, and permits, or other agreements related to any services, facilities or usage of properties and rights-of-way owned by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), and

WHEREAS, GRU wishes to provide to FDOT evidence that its staff has been authorized by the City Commission to approve and execute such deeds, agreements, licenses, permits or other agreements on behalf of the City of Gainesville;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. When standardized documents which have been approved by the City Attorney as to form and legality are used, or when an agreement does not subject GRU to any obligation except the obligation to pay the liquidated agreement amount, the General Manager for Utilities or his designee shall have the authority to bind the City for deeds, easements, agreements, licenses, permits and other agreements related to any services, facilities or usage of properties and rights-of-way owned by the FDOT costing no more than \$100,000.

Section 2. When non-standardized documents are used, or when a document requires GRU to perform work or assume an obligation in addition to the obligation to pay the liquidated agreement amount, the General Manager for Utilities or his designee shall have the authority to bind the City for deeds, easements, agreements, licenses, permits, and other agreements related to any services, facilities or usage of properties and rights-of-way owned by the FDOT, costing no more than \$100,000 and subject to review by the City Attorney as to form and legality.

Section 3. The Clerk of the Commission is authorized to convey a copy of this Resolution to the FDOT at Lake City, Florida.


Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
