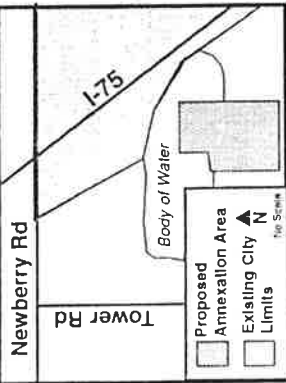


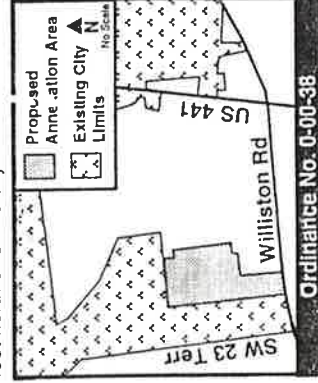
Notice of Voluntary Annexations into the City of Gainesville

NOTICE IS GIVEN THAT THE PROPOSED ORDINANCES NO. 0-00-37 AND 0-00-38 WHOSE TITLES APPEAR BELOW, WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR ENACTMENT ON THE 27TH DAY OF MARCH, 2000 AT THE CITY COMMISSION MEETING STARTING AT 6:00 P.M. OR AS SOON THEREAFTER AS MAY BE HEARD IN THE CITY COMMISSION AUDITORIUM ON THE FIRST FLOOR OF CITY HALL IN GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA, AND IF THEN ADOPTED ON FIRST READING WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR FINAL READING AND ADOPTION ON THE 10TH DAY OF APRIL, 2000 AT THE CITY COMMISSION MEETING AT 6:00 P.M. OR AS SOON THEREAFTER AS MAY BE HEARD IN THE CITY COMMISSION AUDITORIUM ON THE FIRST FLOOR OF CITY HALL IN GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA. A COPY OF SAID ORDINANCES MAY BE INSPECTED BY ANY MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC AT THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK OF THE COMMISSION AT 200 EAST UNIVERSITY AVENUE, GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA. ON BOTH DATES MENTIONED ABOVE ALL INTERESTED PARTIES MAY APPEAR AND BE HEARD WITH RESPECT TO THE PROPOSED ORDINANCES.



Ordinance No. 0-00-37

The area is generally bounded on the north by a body of water contiguous to the Gainesville city limits and I-75, on the east by Circuit City (tax parcel 6654-7), on the west by Tower Center (tax parcel 6654-3) and on the south by the property line of Home Depot located approximately 300 feet north of University Avenue.

The area is generally bounded on the north by the Gainesville city limits, on the east by SW 20th Street and SW 20th Street, on the west by the Gainesville city limits, and on the south by Williston Road.

An Ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, annexing a portion of the City of Gainesville Reserve Area Pursuant to Chapter 90-496, as amended by Chapter 91-382 and Chapter 93-347, Special Acts, Laws of Florida, known as the Alachua County Boundary Adjustment Act; making certain findings; including within the corporate limits of the City of Gainesville, Florida, that certain compact and contiguous area generally bounded on the north by a body of water contiguous to the Gainesville city limits and I-75, on the east by Circuit City (tax parcel 6654-7), on the west by Tower Center (tax parcel 6654-3) and on the south by the property line of Home Depot located approximately 300 feet north of University Avenue; providing for inclusion of the area in Appendix I of the City Charter; providing for land use and zoning regulations; providing directions to the City Manager and Clerk of the Commission; providing a severability clause; and providing an immediate effective date.

An Ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, annexing a portion of the City of Gainesville Reserve Area Pursuant to Chapter 90-496, as amended, by Special Acts, Laws of Florida, known as the Alachua County Boundary Adjustment Act; making certain findings; including within the corporate limits of the City of Gainesville, Florida, that certain compact and contiguous area generally bounded on the north by the Gainesville city limits, on the east by SW 21st Street and SW 20th Street, on the west by the Gainesville city limits, and on the south by Williston Road; providing for inclusion of the area in Appendix I of the City Charter; providing for land use and zoning regulations; providing directions to the City Manager and Clerk of the Commission; providing a severability clause; and providing an immediate effective date.
