2 3 4 5 6 7 8	An ordinance amending the Future Land Use Map of the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan by changing the land use category of approximately 2.8 acres of property generally located at 1303 NE 23rd Avenue, as more specifically described in this ordinance, from Recreation (REC) to Education (E); providing directions to the City Manager; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an effective date.
9 10	WHEREAS, notice was given as required by law that the Future Land Use Map of the City
11	of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan be amended by changing the land use category of certain
12	property from Recreation (REC) to Education (E); and
13	WHEREAS, the amendment to the Future Land Use Map of the City of Gainesville
14	Comprehensive Plan proposed herein involves a use of 10 acres or fewer and qualifies as a small-
15	scale development amendment as provided in Section 163.3187, Florida Statutes; and
16	WHEREAS, notice was given as required by law and a public hearing was held by the City
17	Plan Board on February 28, 2013; and
18	WHEREAS, at least ten (10) days' notice has been given once by publication in a
19	newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a public
20	hearing in the City Hall Auditorium located on the first floor of City Hall in the City of Gainesville
21	and
22	WHEREAS, the public hearing was held pursuant to the notice described above at which
23	hearing the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard.
24	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
25	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

1	Section 1. The Future Land Use Map of the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan is		
2	amended by changing the land use category of the following property from Recreation (REC) to		
3	Education (E):		
4 5 6 7 8	See legal description attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as if set forth in full. The location of the property is shown on Exhibit "B" for visual reference. In the event of conflict or inconsistency, Exhibit "A" shall prevail over Exhibit "B."  Section 2. The City Manager or designee is authorized and directed to make the necessary

10	changes to maps and other data in the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan in order to comply		
11	with this ordinance.		
12	Section 3. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance		
13	or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such		
14	finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given		
15	effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application, and to this end the		
16	provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.		
17	Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of		
18	such conflict hereby repealed.		
19	Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption; however, the		
20	effective date of this plan amendment if not timely challenged shall be 31 days after adoption. If		
21	timely challenged, this plan amendment shall become effective on the date the state land		
22	planning agency or the Administration Commission enters a final order determining this adopted		
23	amendment to the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan to be in compliance with Chapter		
24	163, Florida Statutes. No development orders, development permits, or land uses dependent on		
25	this amendment may be issued or commenced before this plan amendment has become effective.
