WHEREAS, Highway 441 in Alachua County has been renamed the Martin Tuther King, Jr. Highway by House Bill 230, Chapter Taw 88-419; and

WHEREAS, a commemorative march will be held on Monday, January 19, 2015, followed that same day by a program honoring Dr. King.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edward B. Braddy, by the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Gainesville, do hereby proclaim January 11-20, 2015 as
