


- Out of date mapping and scientific data utilized to establish the regulated uplands associated with Strategic Ecosystems.



Suggested Amendments

Allow for removal of Strategic Ecosystem designation from properties with no identified regulated resources.

Increase exemptions to 5 acres.

Develop certainty through a Staff issued environmental review process.
