My name is Scott Daniels and I would like to volunteer to sit on the Historic Preservation Board. I have worked in the University Heights District for over 7 years with Trimark Properties. During that time, I have been responsible for Maintenance at all Trimark Properties. I currently manage a staff of 28 men and women. The roles of my staff vary from Grounds Keepers to skilled Renovations Carpenters. During my tenure at Trimark, I have attempted to bring more of the work that we do "in house". I have coordinated and managed countless water remediation projects, installation of new HVAC equipment and large scale plumbing issues that involved opening floors and walls to re-pipe both supply and drain lines.

After these experiences, I was given the opportunity to start managing small renovation projects at some of our older properties. After 8 minor apartment renovations, several renovations of bathrooms and kitchens in historic houses, and a major repair and renovation at one of Trimark's large historic homes, I was given the Renovations Department to manage as part of my staff.

In the two years since the Renovations Team came under my scope of responsibility, I was able to assist with the complete renovation of 107 SW 7th Street including all of the structural and plumbing repairs. This is an historic building that now houses Parisleaf in the Innovation Square District. I also had the opportunity to manage two, full house renovations on the Solaria North Site, located in the 1000 block SW 6th Avenue. The success of these projects is a source of professional and personal pride.

During the spring of 2015, I took over an exterior renovation to a commercial property in the Innovation Square area that involved modernizing an older, non-descript building. With the help of the Gainesville CRA, Trimark was able to install shade walls, with lighted address signage and metal entry awnings. It was a great opportunity to take what I had learned running historic renovations in a new direction.

This year, I was given the chance to manage the moving of an historic house at 508 SW 10th Street to the lot at 514 SW 10th Street. It was the first time I was involved in moving a house and the experience was interesting and exciting. When the house was lowered onto the new stem wall, we immediately began the full renovation of the home. We are adding a bathroom, increasing the size of an existing bathroom and renovating the third bathroom and kitchen. On the exterior, we will be adding a covered wraparound porch. The work on the house is scheduled to be completed by April 30, 2016. On May 1st, our team will move straight into the next renovation on our schedule at 609 SW 9th Street.

Being allowed to be a part of these projects has been an honor for me. Since my first visit to a Trimark Properties in 2008, I was impressed with the detail that went into the historic renovations. I am still pleased with the attention that is given when matching the architecture of our new construction to the existing contributing structures on the building sites.

My experiences as a Project Manager and Salesman at Ridgway Truss Company, as well as the skills I learned in the Construction Management Technologies Program at Santa Fe Community College, have given me the prerequisites to be a successful manager in our Historic Renovations Department. At Ridgway, I oversaw the design and, when necessary, the installation of roof and floor trusses during new construction projects, additions or major repairs. During my time at Ridgway, I learned to tie new

sections of roof and floor systems into existing buildings. This experience has allowed me to see the possibilities a building holds at the beginning of a renovation project.

I also manage a landscape company. Urban Greenscapes, LLC came to be in April of 2015. The landscape company performs maintenance, design and install for properties in the University Heights area. In October 2015, we took over maintenance at four Gainesville CRA signature sites. Urban Greenscapes also just finished installing plants in beds that are around the Downtown Plaza. With the help of the CRA, we were able to design the bed layouts on the perimeter of the renovated plaza. Our plantings tied SE 1st Street into the landscaping plan for the plaza.

I was raised in Yorktown, Virginia and later attended High School in Downtown Charleston, South Carolina. I grew up admiring historic buildings in both of these history rich areas. I would like to use that interest, knowledge and experience to become part of the important process that keeps the character of our city intact.

I believe that my experiences with historic renovations will be a benefit to the Historic Preservation Board. Furthermore, I will benefit by giving something back to the community that I have called home since 1994. I would ask that you consider me to fill the vacant seat on the City of Gainesville Historic Preservation Board.
