4	An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending the			
5	City of Gainesville Code of Ordinances, relating to the hours of			
6	sale, service and consumption of alcohol by amending section			
7 8	4-2 and 4-5(a) to permit sale, service and/or consumption on			
9	Sunday commensurate with permissible hours on Monday through Saturday; providing directions to the codifier;			
10	providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause;			
11	and providing an immediate effective date.

13	WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a newspape			
14	of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a public hearing to			
15	be held in the City Commission Auditorium, City Hall, City of Gainesville; and			
16	WHEREAS, the Public Hearings were held pursuant to the published notice			
17	described at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and			
18	were, in fact, heard.			
19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF			
20	THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:			
21	Section 1. Subsections (a) and (b) of Section 4-2, Gainesville Code of			
22	Ordinances, is amended to read as follows:			
23	Sec. 4-2 Hours of sale.			
24	(a) Alcoholic beverages by the package, other than packaged beer and			
25	unfortified wine. No beverage licensee, or employee or agent of such			
26	licensee, permitted under state law to sell alcoholic beverages by the			
27	package, bottle or original container shall sell, offer for sale, serve or			
28	deliver such a product (other than packaged beer and unfortified wine)			

1	for consumption either on or off the premises during the following			
2	hours (time is local time):			
3	(1) Any time Sunday, except if December 31 occurs on a Sunday,			
4	sales will be permitted between 6:00 p.m. that day and 2:00			
5	a.m. the following day.			
6	(2) 11:00 p.m. to midnight Monday through Saturday.			
7	(3) Midnight to 7:00 a.m. Monday through Saturday. the following			
8	day, all days.			
9	(b) All other alcoholic beverages. No beverage licensee, or employee or			
10	agent of such licensee, shall sell, offer for sale, serve, or permit to be			
11	sold or served or consumed, any alcoholic beverage not regulated			
12	under subsection (a) in a place operating under the beverage license,			
13	for consumption either on or off the premises, during the following			
14	hours (time is local time):			
15	(1) 2:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., all days.			
16	(2) 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Sunday.			
17	(3) 11:00 p.m. Sunday to 2:00 a.m. the following day, except if			
18	December 31 occurs on a Sunday, this restriction shall not			
19	apply on that day.			
20	Section 2. Subsection (a) of Section 4-5, Gainesville Code of			
21	Ordinances, is amended to read as follows:			
22	Sec. 4-5 Consumption on certain premises prohibited during certain hours.			

1	(a) It is unlawful for any person to consume or to permit the consumption of any		
2	alcoholic beverages in bottle clubs or on premises open to the public, catering to the		
3	sale and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and		
4	7:00 a.m., all days. immediately following on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday,		
5	Friday, or Saturday, or between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. on Sunday, or		
6	between the hours of 11:00 p.m. on Sunday and 7:00 a.m. immediately following on		
7	Monday. All time is Eastern standard time or Eastern daylight saving time, whichever		
8	is in effect.		
9	Section 3. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of		
10	Sections 1 and 2 shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of		
11	Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be		
12	renumbered or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions.		
13	Section 4. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this		
14	ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or		
15	unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the		
16	ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or		
17	application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.		
18	Section 5. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the		
19	extent of such conflict hereby repealed.		
20	Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
