#### **HISTORY OF STRIKE OUT HUNGER FOOD DRIVE**

- September 16, 2008 Alachua County Initiates First Strike Out Hunger Food Drive Held at Citizens Field in recognition of National Hunger Month and to promote the Hunger Summit.
- 26, 000 pounds of food raised.
- September 18, 2008 First Hunger Summit sponsored by Alachua County, City of Gainesville, Alachua County Medical Society, Alachua County School Board and United Way to begin the process of developing a Hunger Abatement Plan.

#### HISTORY OF STRIKE OUT HUNGER FOOD DRIVE

- July 2009, Alachua County approved the Hunger Abatement Plan.
- 2009, City of Gainesville adopts the Hunger Abatement Plan.
- Alachua County Nutrition Alliance (ACNA) organized to implement the HAP Plan.
- 2011 First Community Wide Strike Out Hunger Food Drive Held at The Fairgrounds to create a public private partnership.


