ORDINANCE NO. _____

An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, amending Appendix I of the City Charter, by redefining the Legal Description of Municipal Corporate Limits, as more specifically described in this Ordinance; providing directions to the codifier; providing directions to the Clerk of the Commission; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an immediate effective date.

WHEREAS, at least 10 days notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a public hearing to be held in the City Commission Auditorium, City Hall, City of Gainesville; and

WHEREAS, the Public Hearings were held pursuant to the published notice described at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Appendix I of the City Charter is hereby replaced in its entirety with the revised Appendix I, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and made a part hereof as if set forth in full.

Section 2. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Charter Laws of the City of Gainesville, Florida.

Section 3. The corporate limits of the City of Gainesville, Florida, as set forth in the Appendix I, Charter Laws of the City of Gainesville, are amended and revised as described in

Section 1.

Section 4. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

Section 5. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

Section 6. The Clerk of the Commission is directed to submit a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Florida Department of State in accordance with Section 166.031(3), F.S.

Section 7. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption.
