Subject: Sole Source Justification

The Gainesville Police Department is in the process of renewing an agreement with the Department of Juvenile Justice to defray the security costs for the operation of the Gainesville Regional Juvenile Assessment Center (JAC) for the period of October 1, 2011 through September 30, 2012.

The department needs the requested funds from the City of Gainesville, to assist in funding the costs for security staff assigned at the center. The Center must have a live scan computer system; the State of Florida has agreed to provide this service. Live Scan is inkless fingerprinting, which is electronically transmitted to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) for completion of a criminal record check.

Florida State Statutes require a criminal justice agency may allow access to their data/information systems via the CJNet upon approval of the Florida Criminal and Juvenile Information Systems (CJJIS) Council.

Therefore for the aforementioned reason it will make it impossible for the City of Gainesville to place this in a bid process.
