A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA; RELATING TO ITS GENERAL GOVERNMENT BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2016 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2017; AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 160305, AS AMENDED BY RESOLUTION NO. 160759 AND RESOLUTION NO. 160955, BY MAKING CERTAIN ADJUSTMENTS TO THE GENERAL OPERATING AND FINANCIAL PLAN BUDGET; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 15, 2016, the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida, adopted Resolution No. 160305 for the purpose of approving and adopting a final budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017;

WHEREAS, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 160759 on April 20, 2017 and adopted Resolution No. 160955 on July 6, 2017, each of which amended Resolution No. 160305 by amending the General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget as set forth therein;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to make certain amendments to the General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget in order to fund their activities;

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires now to amend the General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget as fully set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

1 **Section 1.** The General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget for Fiscal
2 Year 2016-2017 is hereby amended as set forth in Attachment “A” which is attached hereto and
3 made part hereof as if set forth in full.

4 **Section 2.** Except as herein above modified and amended, the General Government
5 Financial and Operating Plan Budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 as adopted by Resolution No.
6 160305 and amended by Resolution No. 160759 and Resolution No. 160955 shall continue and
7 remain in full effect.

8 **Section 3.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
