Dear John:

As you know, on Monday, January 22<sup>nd</sup>, the City Commission considered the Inter-local Agreement for the Academy of Business Ownership No action was taken on the agreement and several issues were raised regarding its contents These include:

- Whether future Entrepreneur Economic Development Trust Fund dollars will be made available only to City residents;
- The specific mechanisms by which Entrepreneur Economic Development Trust Fund dollars will be administered to future applicants; and
- An indication of the nexus between the Academy of Business Ownership and the Entrepreneurial Charter School in administration of Entrepreneur Economic Development Trust Fund dollars and the future management relationship between the Alachua County School Board, Alachua County, City of Gainesville and Entrepreneurial Charter School Board

Based upon City Commission direction, these issues will need to be resolved in the context of a revised Inter-local agreement before future consideration of the matter by the City Commission.

Although the City Commission directed that no action take place until the aforementioned issues are resolved, the Commission did approve \$11,075 towards the establishment of mentoring services for the Academy As we have discussed, we await an invoice from your office with appropriate documentation to process that request

Please let me know how I can be of service in the future regarding revision of the Interlocal agreement and rescheduling of this item before the City Commission for action
