





### What are our assets...

- Greatest Asset is Knowledge
- Several high-growth industries/economy drivers: Biomedical, Research, Professional Services, Logistics
- High research capacity: UF awarded more than \$560 million in research awards; doubled since 1999
- Center of knowledge formation: around 150 patents awarded in region each year; 50% in Life Science
- Strong commercialization and start-up activity: \$52 million in licensing income at UF (tripled since 1999); 9 start-ups in 2007 alone



### What are the barriers...

- "Scarcity Mindset" is compromising willingness and ability to collaborate – need to shift to "Abundance Mindset"
- Existing gaps that will impede innovation and future growth:
  - Lack of connectivity/collaborative mindset
  - Student and youth talent underdeveloped
  - Ineffective public-private partnerships
  - Lack of strong brand and external communications strategy



- Funding discussions are underway with organization and individuals for start-up and early stage
- U.S. Department of Energy to fund regional Energy Innovation Hubs
- FloridaWorks pursuing federal and state funds to spur job creations and best practices training
- FloridaWorks securing training funds for green industry certifications
