- Major changes to the Florida Growth Management laws (Chapter Law 2011-139) made transportation concurrency optional & eliminated TCEAs
- Both the Plan Board & City Commission supported Planning staff's recommendation to rescind transportation concurrency as part of the Evaluation & Appraisal update of the Comprehensive Plan

Background cont.

- **The Plan Board & City Commission also supported replacing the TCEA with a new, citywide transportation mobility program**

Changes

- **One of the components of rescinding transportation concurrency is deletion of the Concurrency Management Element**
- **Petition PB-12-133 CPA shows the Concurrency Management Element as completely stricken through & maps deleted**
- **The new Transportation Mobility Program will be placed in the Transportation Mobility Element**
