- 1- If an owner can verify they are renting to "affordable housing" tenants" ie: with proving food stamps (and any other ways the housing authority does) the owners should be exempt to the land lord permits each year they help with this.
- 2- Permit should be a \$40 flat fee and if not paid the following should follow:

1<sup>st</sup> violation if not paid, a letter of reprimand in the file and a letter sent with regards to what the requirements are and what will happen is not paid in the future:

2<sup>nd</sup> offence \$150.00 fine collected

3<sup>rd</sup> offence \$300.00 fine collected

4<sup>th</sup> revocation of land lord permit, unless the property is sold.

We have been on the commission for the Code Enforcement for 2-5 years and feel this is the right thing to do because of the times we are in and also show understanding for our citizens of the City of Gainesville....
