14	which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact,

16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
17	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:
18	Section 1. Section 7-15 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, is amended
19	to read as follows:
20	Sec. 7-15. Certificate of purchase of perpetual care service.
21	Upon the payment of a perpetual care fee, the director of finance city manager or
22	designee is authorized to deliver to the purchaser a certificate evidencing the purchase, signed by
23	him/her on behalf of the city.
24	Section 2. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Section 1
25	shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, Florida,
26	and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be renumbered or relettered in order
27	to accomplish such intentions.

28	Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held to be
29	invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no
30	way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
31	Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of
32	such conflict hereby repealed.
33	Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
