SERVICE CHARGES BY INCREASING CERTAIN ADDITIONAL CHARGES FOR SAME DAY OR AFTER HOURS INSTALLATION OR TURN-ON OF SERVICE; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING DIRECTIONS TO THE CODIFIER; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SCHEDULE PROVIDED HEREIN.		
9	WHEREAS, at least ten (10) days notice has been given of the public hearings once		
20	by publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed

26	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY

29	Section 1. That Subsection 27-15(a) of the Code of Ordinances of Gainesville,		
30	Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:		
31	(a). Installation or turn-on of utility service. A service charge in accordance with the		
32	schedule set out in Appendix A shall be paid to the city before any utility service,

new or transferred from one service location to another, is installed or turned on. Should installation or turn-on services be requested for the same workday, or after normal working hours or for any fully-scheduled workday requiring after-hours service, or for holidays or weekends, additional service charges in accordance with the schedule set out in Appendix A shall be assessed. Should application be made at the same time for any combination of electric, water and/or wastewater, or any other service at the same premises, only one service charge shall be assessed. However, the assessed service charge shall be that service charge which is the greatest of all those applicable. Gas service charges shall be assessed independent of other requested utility services.

10	Section 3. It is the intention of the City Commission that the provisions of Sections 1		
11	and 2 of this Ordinance shall become and be made a part of the Code of Ordinances of the		
12	City of Gainesville, Florida, and that the Sections and Paragraphs of this Ordinance may be		
13	renumbered or relettered in order to accomplish such intentions.		
14	Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the		
15	extent of such conflict hereby repealed.		
16	Section 5. If any portion of this ordinance is declared invalid by a court of		
17	competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this		
18	ordinance.		
19	Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption;		
20	provided however, the rates and charges as provided for herein shall be applicable to all		
21	monthly bills which are for the first time rendered and postmarked after 12:01 A.M.,		
22	October 1, 2006.
