A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA; RELATING TO THE LEVY OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSE AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE 2006-2007 FISCAL YEAR; ESTABLISHING PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE; SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING; PROVIDING FOR NOTICE TO THE ALACHUA COUNTY PROPERTY APPRAISER; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Alachua County Property Appraiser certified the 2006 taxable values to the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida on June 9, 2006.

WHEREAS, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, requires the City Commission to advise the Property Appraiser of its rolled-back millage rate, its proposed millage rate, and of the time, date, and place at which a public hearing will be held to consider the proposed millage rate and the proposed tentative budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The rolled-back millage rate for the general municipal purpose, as computed pursuant to Section 200.065 (1), Florida Statutes, is 4.3083 mills.

Section 2. The proposed millage rate necessary to fund the proposed tentative general purpose municipal budget for the City of Gainesville's 2006-2007 fiscal year is 4.9250 mills.
