An Ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, annexing a

County Boundary Adjustment Act; making certain findings;

including within the corporate limits of the City of Gainesville, Florida, that certain compact and contiguous area located

generally south of Blues Creek subdivision and the City limits, west of NW 51st Terrace, north of the vicinity of NW 54th Drive

and 52nd Terrace, and east of NW 52nd Drive; providing for

inclusion of the area in Appendix I of the City Charter;

providing for a referendum election; providing directions to the City Manager and Clerk of the Commission; providing ballot

language; providing for land use plan and zoning regulations;

designated the Reserve Area for the City of Gainesville pursuant to the Act; and

WHEREAS, on August 9, 2004, the City Commission of the City of Gainesville adopted

Ordinance No. 031302, which adopted the Urban Services Report setting forth the plans to provide

1 urban services to that portion of the Reserve Area proposed to be annexed in accordance			
2	procedures provided in the Act; and		
3	WHEREAS, a copy of the Urban Services Report was filed with the Alachua County		
4	Board of County Commissioners; and		
5	WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville desires to annex a certain portion of its Reserve Area		
6	which is compact and contiguous to the present corporate limits of the City; and		
7	WHEREAS, pursuant to law, at least 10 days notice has been given by publication in a		
8	newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of the first Public Hearing of this proposed		
9	Ordinance to be held in the City Commission meeting room, First Floor, City Hall, in the City of		
10	Gainesville; and		
11	WHEREAS, pursuant to law, at least 10 days notice has been given by publication in a		
12	newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of the second Public Hearing of this proposed		
13	Ordinance to be held in the City Commission meeting room, First Floor, City Hall, in the City of		
14	Gainesville; and		
15	WHEREAS, Public Hearings were held pursuant to the published notice described above at		
16	which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact,		
17	heard.		
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE		
19	CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:		
20	Section 1. The City Commission finds that the Area described in Section 2 of this		
21	Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as the "Area") is contiguous and reasonably compact to the		
22	present corporate limits of the City of Geinesville, and that no part of the Area is within the		

- boundary of another municipality or county. The City Commission finds the Area to be within its
- 2 Reserve Area and the annexation does not create an enclave. The City Commission finds the Area
- 3 is developed for urban purposes because it has a total resident population of at least two persons per
- 4 acre of land included within its boundaries.
- 5 Section 2. The following described Area is annexed and incorporated within the corporate
- 6 limits of the City of Gainesville, Florida:
- See Legal Description attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and made a part hereof as if set forth in full.

- **Section 3.** Subject to the provisions of Section 4 of this Ordinance, the corporate limits of the City of Gainesville, Florida, as set forth in Article 1, Charter Laws of the City of Gainesville, are amended and revised to include the Area described in Section 2 within the corporate limits of the City of Gainesville, Florida.
- Section 4. Pursuant to Section 8 of the Act, this Ordinance shall be submitted to a vote of the registered electors of the Area described in Section 2 of this Ordinance at a special election called for the purpose of holding the referendum. The referendum election shall be held on Tuesday, February 15, 2005. The referendum shall be conducted by the Alachua County Supervisor of Elections ("Supervisor") in accordance with the provisions of the Act and Chapter 9, Gainesville Code of Ordinances, as applicable. The Supervisor is requested and authorized to conduct a mail ballot election in this referendum in accordance with the provisions of the Mail Ballot Election Act as codified in Chapter 101, Florida Statutes. The City Manager is authorized
- **Section 5.** The Clerk of the Commission is authorized to publish notice of the referendum on annexation as prescribed by law.

and directed to pay all lawful expenses associated with the election.

Section 6. Pursuant to Section 8 of the Act, the language to appear on the ballot of the 1 referendum election called in Section 4 shall be: 2 "For annexation of property described in Ordinance Number 3 4 of the City of Gainesville" 5 6 "Against annexation of property described in Ordinance Number 7 of the City of Gainesville" 8 9 Section 7. In accordance with Section 171.062, Florida Statutes, the Alachua County land 10 use plan and zoning or subdivision regulations shall remain in full force and effect in the Area 11 described in Section 2 of this Ordinance until the City adopts a comprehensive plan amendment 12 that includes the annexed area. The Gainesville Code Enforcement Board and code enforcement 13 officers shall have jurisdiction to enforce these regulations during the interim period through the 14 Gainesville Code Enforcement Board process as described in Division 8 of Article V of Chapter 2 15 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville and the Civil Citation Process, as described in 16 Division 6 of Article V of Chapter 2 of said Code. During the interim period, the City may rezone 17 properties in the annexed area to an Alachua County Zoning classification/category that conforms 18 with the Alachua County Comprehensive Plan. 19 Section 8. (a) Except as provided in subsections (b) and (c) below, all persons who are 20 lawfully engaged in any occupation, business, trade or profession within the area described in 21 Section 2 of this Ordinance as of March 1, 2005, shall have the right to continue such occupation, 22 business, trade or profession. 23 (b) Except as provided in subsection (c) below, all persons who are lawfully engaged in any

construction trade, occupation or business within the Area described in Section 2 of this Ordinance

as of March 1, 2005, and who possess a valid certificate of competency issued by Alachua County

- shall have the right to continue the construction trade, occupation, or business within the entire
- 2 corporate limits of the City of Gainesville, including the Area described in Section 2 of this
- 3 Ordinance, subject to the terms, conditions and limitations imposed on the certificate by Alachua
- 4 County, and provided such persons register the certificate with the Building Inspections Department
- of the City of Gainesville and the Department of Business and Professional Regulation of the State
- of Florida, if applicable, on or before 4:00 p.m. on March 1, 2005.
- 7 (c) All persons lawfully engaged in any occupation, business, trade or profession within the
- 8 Area described in Section 2 of this Ordinance on or after October 1, 2005, shall obtain an
- 9 occupational license from the city of Gainesville for the term commencing on October 1, 2005,
- which license shall be issued upon payment of the appropriate fee in accordance with the
- Gainesville Code of Ordinances in effect on October 1, 2005.
- 12 Section 9. If any portion of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction
- to be invalid or unenforceable, such declaration shall not be deemed to affect the remaining
- portions of this Ordinance.
- 15 Section 10. The Clerk of the Commission is directed to submit a certified copy of this
- Ordinance to: 1) the Executive Office of the Governor; 2) the Florida Department of State; and 3)
- the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the Eighth Judicial Circuit in and for Alachua County, Florida.
- 18 Section 11. Sections 1, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10 and 11 of this Ordinance shall become effective
- immediately upon adoption. Sections 2, 3, and 7 shall become effective at 12:01 a.m. on March 1,
- 20 2005, unless there is a tie vote or majority vote against the annexation at the special election called
- in Section 4 of this Ordinance.
