Lobbyist Registration History

- June 2007: City Commission referred issue of lobbyist registration to Charter Officers for development and report back to Audit, Finance and Legislative Committee (AFLC)
- November 2007 and June 2008: Charter
 Officers reviewed lobbyist registration
 requirements at state and local government level
 in Florida and presented several options to the
 AFLC for discussion
- June 2008: City Commission authorized City Attorney to draft an ordinance establishing lobbyist registration requirements



Ordinance No. 0-08-12

- Creates Lobbyist Registration Act
- Establishes rules for lobbyists engaging in efforts to influence City
 Commissioners or CRA members
- Requires lobbyists to register and provide general identification and client information
- Contains enforcement provisions



Definitions

- Lobbying means communicating, directly or indirectly, with any City Commissioner or CRA member with intent to encourage the passage, defeat, modification or repeal of any item that may be presented for a vote before the City Commission or CRA
- Lobbyist means any person who is employed and receives payment, or who contracts for economic consideration of any kind, for the purpose of lobbying



Summary

- Lobbyist registration is about providing greater transparency in government by making more visible the influences on government decision making
- Lobbyist registration will not in any way prohibit lobbying
- Lobbyist registration will not require payment of fees or submission of compensation reports



Summary

- Registration statements will be submitted to the Clerk of the Commission and be valid for one year
- The Clerk's Office will maintain a current list of registered lobbyists and the registration statements required
- All documentation will be open for public inspection
