A Resolution of the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida, authorizing the City Manager to execute a Joint Participation Agreement between the City of Gainesville and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to receive Service Development Funds for Route 22.

WHEREAS, the City of Gainesville owns and operates the public transit system serving the Gainesville urbanized area in Alachua County; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) makes available Service Development Grant Funds for transit projects every year; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation requires the execution of a Joint Participation Agreement by the City and the provision of matching funds; and

WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the applicant, including provision of the local share of the project costs; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) requires the governing board of each public transit system to adopt a resolution authorizing the acceptance of these funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

- 1. That the City of Gainesville Regional Transit System (RTS) confirms its desire to enter into a Joint Participation Agreement (JPA) with the State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT).
- 2. That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a Joint Participation Agreement (JPA) including any Supplemental Joint Participation Agreements (SJPA) for the purpose of Scope Changes and/or funding adjustments, as well as execute Assurances, Certifications, and all other documents as may be required in support of transit services for Route 22.
- 3. That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to accept the allocation for the City of Gainesville for the provision of transit services for Route 22.
- 4. That the City Manager or his designee is authorized to sign requests for Contract Time Extension(s), as may be required in support of transit services for Route 22.
- 5. That the City Manager, within the City's approved budget, is authorized to provide the local share to match such grant funds as may be required.
- 6. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
