PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the 12th Annual Great American Cleanup in Alachua County coordinated by Keep Alachua County Beautiful will be observed Saturday, April 16, 2005; and

WHEREAS, Keep America Beautiful, The Gainesville Sun, City of Gainesville, Alachua County, Waste Management, Inc., Waste Pro, Gladhouses, Force Flex Trash Bags, SP Recycling, Southland Waste Systems, Publix, Gator Domino's Pieza, Gainesville Coca-Cola, Firestone Tires, Sam's Club, Wrigley Gum, Troy-Bilt, and Honda sponsor the cleanup along with many, many other contributors; and

WHEREAS, last year 9,651 volunteers representing 141 groups picked up 287 tons of trash and recyclables with a fiscal benefit to the community of over \$165,706; and

WHEREAS, there were lasting reminder projects such as trees, shrubs, and flowers planted, graffiti removed, illegal dumps cleaned up and permanently cordoned off, houses, bridges and walls painted; and
