Dean Mimms gave an updated presentation of the signage focused for the Waldo Road from SE 1st Avenue to NE 39th Avenue, both sides of the road. Sign Code changes are not contemplated for all sign codes on Waldo Road and no changes to wall mounted signs only ground mounted signs. Comments ranged in discussion of sign heights 8' vs 10', pole vs monument, LED timed lettering, current sign conditions and maintenance, amortized matching upgrade funds, Waldo Road as a model for signage code ordinance update, signage external vs internal lighting, re-facing of existing signs for new businesses and research of other city sign codes. The EDUCC instructed Staff to bring back information regarding re-facing of existing signs for new businesses.
