Subject: RE: Gainesville Renewable Energy Center, PA09-55, Petition for Modification (Mod A)

On Tuesday, you received the below email from me describing a modification to the Conditions of Certification for the Gainesville Renewable Energy Center in Alachua County.

To clarify, this is a modification initiated by the Department in order to modify specific DEP conditions to reflect rule updates, and (consistent with Section 403.7047, Florida Statutes) to allow ash generated at the facility to be transported offsite for beneficial reuse at a facility properly permitted to receive such materials.

Specifically, the Department intends to modify Sections B.I.C. and B.I.D. of the Conditions that require GREC to comply with provisions of Chapter 62-702, Florida Administrative Code. Chapter 62-702 was repealed by the Department in 2012 and thus is no longer applicable to GREC. Additionally, in 2013, the Florida Legislature created Section 403.7047, Florida Statutes, which encourages the beneficial use of ash generated by electrical power plants. Conditions B.I.C and B.I.D currently require ash to be transported offsite for disposal in a permitted landfill.

This email is for the purpose of notification of the Department's intent to modify these conditions, and to allow the reviewing agencies the opportunity to ask questions or comment on the Department's intended action prior to the issuance of the Notice of Intent to Modify and Draft Final Order.

We hope this helps to clarify Tuesday's correspondence and please feel free to contact me with any questions or concerns.
