

**RESOLUTION NO. 20-005
EFFECTIVE APRIL 23, 2020**

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF A CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF AND ECONOMIC SECURITY (CARES) ACT (H.B. 748) GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION, ON BEHALF OF THE GAINESVILLE-ALACHUA COUNTY REGIONAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2020, President Donald J. Trump signed into law the CARES Act which includes \$10 billion in funds to be awarded as economic relief to eligible U.S. airports, affected by the prevention of, preparation for, and response to the COVID-19 pandemic, including support for continuing airport operations; and

WHEREAS, FAA CARES Act funds may be used for any purpose for which airport funds may be lawfully used, as found in the Office of Airports Revenue Use Policy; and

WHEREAS, FAA CARES Act funds do not require a local match; and

WHEREAS, any grant offer made by the USDOT Federal Aviation Administration will be presented to the co-sponsor, the City of Gainesville, for approval and legal review;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GAINESVILLE-ALACHUA COUNTY REGIONAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY, as follows:

Section 1. That the Gainesville-Alachua County Regional Airport Authority approves an application for FAA CARES Act funding in the amount of \$3,113,693.

Section 2. The Gainesville-Alachua County Regional Airport Authority, being familiar with expected terms of said Grant Offer, does hereby ratify and adopt all statements, representations, warranties, covenants, and agreements contained in said Offer, and by such acceptance, agree to abide by all of the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement.

Section 3. That the Gainesville-Alachua County Regional Airport Authority hereby authorizes Allan J. Penksa, Chief Executive Officer, to accept the FAA CARES Act Grant Agreement offer from the USDOT, subject to review by the Attorney for the Authority, and to fully execute and sign such documents as may be necessary.
