

1 **WHEREAS**, on September 8, 2016, the City Commission held the public hearing as
2 specified in the Notice of Proposed Property Taxes and in accordance with applicable law; and

3 **WHEREAS**, on September 8, 2016, the City Commission of the City of Gainesville,
4 Florida, adopted Resolution No. 160302 approving a tentative millage rate necessary to fund the
5 Amended Tentative General Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget;

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7 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE**
8 **CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:**

9 **Section 1.** The final operating millage rate of 4.5079 mills to fund the Final General
10 Government Financial and Operating Plan Budget for the City of Gainesville’s 2016-2017 fiscal
11 year is approved.

12 **Section 2.** The General Fund operating millage rate approved herein is more than the
13 rolled-back rate of 4.4057 mills, which results in a 2.32% increase in property taxes.

14 **Section 3.** The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to transmit copies of this
15 Resolution, as well as any other forms or documents required by law, to the Alachua County
16 Property Appraiser, Alachua County Tax Collector, and the Florida Dept. of Revenue within
17 three (3) days after the adoption of this Resolution.

18 **Section 4.** In the event the City is notified by the Alachua County Property Appraiser of
19 an aggregate change in the assessment roll of more than one (1) percent pursuant to Section
20 200.065(6), Florida Statutes, then the millage rate adopted in Section 1 of this Resolution may be
21 adjusted in accordance with Section 200.065(6), Florida Statutes. The City Manager is hereby
22 authorized to compute the adjustments as provided in Section 200.065(6) and administratively
23 adjust the millage rates. The City Manager is also authorized and directed to execute an official


1 notification of the millage adjustment and shall deliver the same to the Alachua County Property
2 Appraiser within three (3) days of the receipt of any notice of aggregate change in the assessment
3 roll.


4 **Section 5.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
