21	WHEREAS, notice was given and publication made as required by law and a public
22	hearing was held by the City Plan Board on November 1, 2011; and
23	WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that the rezoning of the property described
24	herein is consistent with the City of Gainesville Comprehensive Plan; and
25	WHEREAS, at least ten (10) days notice has been given of the public hearing once by

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, notice has also been given by mail to the owner whose property will be regulated by the adoption of this Ordinance, at least thirty days prior to the date

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set for a public hearing on this ordinance; and 1 2 WHEREAS, Public Hearings were held pursuant to the published and mailed notices 3 described above at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard. 4 5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA: 6 Section 1. The Zoning Map Atlas of the City of Gainesville is amended by rezoning the 7 following described property from the Alachua County zoning category of "Planned 8 development (PD) district" to the City of Gainesville zoning category of "PS: Public services 9 and operations district", as more specifically described below: 10 11 See legal description, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof as if set forth in full. 12 13 Section 2. The City Commission finds that a preliminary development plan 14 is not required in connection with this rezoning. 15 16 Section 3. The uses permitted by right on the property described in Section 1 of this 17 Ordinance are telecommunications facilities, utility buildings or facilities (as defined by Section 30-23 of the Land Development Code), stormwater management facilities, and any use 18 19 customarily incidental to any permitted principal use. **Section 4.** The following conditions also apply to the use and development of this 20 21 property:

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1. Changes to the site shall require development plan approval in accordance with the

requirements of the City's Land Development Code and the adopted PS zoning

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1	ordinance.
2	2. The subject property shall be regulated in accordance with the requirements of the City's
3	Land Development Code and all other applicable regulations.
4	Section 5. The City Manager is authorized and directed to make the necessary changes
5	in the Zoning Map to comply with this Ordinance.
6	Section 6. If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section or provision of this ordinance
7	or the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such
8	finding shall not affect the other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given
9	effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or application, and to this end the
10	provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
11	Section 7. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of
12	such conflict hereby repealed.
13	Section 8. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption.
