ORDINANCE NO. 190989

An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, to vacate, abandon, and close a public right-of-way on NW 4th Lane lying between NW 13th Street and NW 14th

Street, as more specifically described in this ordinance; providing directions to

the Clerk of the Commission; providing a severability clause; providing a

repealing clause; and providing an effective date.

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WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 30-3.41 of the City of Gainesville's Land Development Code (Chapter 30 of the City of Gainesville Code of Ordinances), an application was initiated by the owner(s) of land abutting the subject public right-of-way requesting the City to vacate, abandon, and close the right-of-way; and WHEREAS, the request to vacate the subject public right-of-way was presented to and approved by the appropriate departments of the City of Gainesville; and WHEREAS, the City Plan Board, which acts pursuant to the authority granted in Section 4.02 of the Charter Laws of the City of Gainesville and which acts as the Local Planning Agency pursuant to Section 163.3174, Florida Statutes, held a public hearing on February 27, 2020, and voted to recommend that the City Commission approve this vacation of public right-of-way; and WHEREAS, at least 10 days' notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper of general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of public hearings to be held by the City Commission of the City of Gainesville; and WHEREAS, public hearings were held pursuant to the notice described above at which hearings the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard; and WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that the vacation of the subject right-of-way meets the

- 1 required criteria in Policy 10.2.1 of the Transportation Mobility Element of the Comprehensive
- 2 Plan and Section 30-3.41 of the Land Development Code.
- 3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE,
- 4 FLORIDA:
- 5 SECTION 1. The following described public right-of-way is hereby vacated, abandoned, and
- 6 closed for use by the public generally:
- See legal description attached as **Exhibit A** and made a part hereof as if set forth in full. The location of the property is shown on **Exhibit B** for visual reference. In the event of conflict or inconsistency, **Exhibit A** will prevail over **Exhibit B**.
- SECTION 2. The City reserves unto itself, its successors and assigns a public and private utilities
- easement over, under, across, and through the property described in Section 1 of this
- ordinance for the purpose of installing, maintaining, and operating public and private utilities.
- 14 **SECTION 3.** The Clerk of the Commission or designee is authorized to record a true copy of this
- ordinance in the public records of Alachua County, Florida.
- 16 **SECTION 4.** If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section, or provision of this ordinance or
- 17 the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such
- finding will not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given
- 19 effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application, and to this end the
- 20 provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.
- 21 **SECTION 5.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of such
- 22 conflict hereby repealed.
- 23 **SECTION 6.** This ordinance will become effective immediately upon adoption.

Legal Description

NW 4th Lane R/W Vacation:

That portion of NW 4th Lane (a 20' wide R/W) according to the plat thereof recorded in Plat Book "A", Page 63 of the Public Records of Alachua County, Florida, lying East of NW 14th Street and West of NW 13th Street.
