# **RUC CURRENT ACTION ITEMS**

# 080421. Evaluation of Rates for Reclaimed Water - Discussion of Proposed Changes to GRU's Reclaimed Water Policy (B)

*Explanation:* On May 13, 2009 staff presented the proposed reclaimed water master plan and changes to GRU's reclaimed water extension policy. The proposed policy changes will increase the expansion of reclaimed water service over a broader area. Broader expansion of the reclaimed water system will help to off-set potable water demands for irrigation and other non-potable uses, provide beneficial aquifer recharge, and provide environmentally sustainable wastewater disposal.

Staff will provide follow-up discussion on the following items, as requested by RUC members during the May 13 meeting:

1. Potential reclaimed water service to the Ironwood Golf Course and surrounding areas;

2. Phasing of increases to water/wastewater connection charges;

3. Impact of increasing reclaimed water usage charges; and

4. Comparison of GRU reclaimed water usage charges to those of other utilities.

*Fiscal Note:* The proposed reclaimed water expansion is projected to cost approximately \$45 million over the next 20 years. Staff is proposing to fund this primarily through reclaimed water usage charges and by increasing wastewater connection charges.

The Regional Utilities Committee (RUC) receive a presentation from staff, and recommend that City Commission approve proposed changes to GRU's reclaimed water extension policy.

One example of its implementation is the inclusion of "industrial symbiosis" to promote green industry at Deerhaven in the recent (and unanimously approved) zoning designation for the plant site. # 070084. City of Gainesville Energy Policy - Gainesville Energy Advisory Committee (GEAC) (NB)

Explanation:On July 9, 2007 the City Commission referred the issue of a City of Gainesville<br/>Energy Policy to the Regional Utilities Committee. Given the actions taken by<br/>the City Commission to promote energy efficiency and secure renewable power<br/>supplies, Richard Williams, Chair of the Gainesville Energy Advisory<br/>Committee reports that he is directing its attention toward an "energy<br/>dashboard" program. The purpose of the dashboard is to measure and<br/>benchmark energy efficiency in three sectors: 1) electricity production; 2)<br/>energy consumption in the community; and 3) energy consumption by City<br/>operations. Mr. Williams agrees with staff's recommendation that the Energy<br/>Policy issue should be removed from the referral list.
