#### 130261. Sidewalk Cafés (B)

Committee

Explanation: Section 30-121 of the City's Land Development Code regulates sidewalk cafés on the right-of-way by requiring business owners to apply for a City license and to maintain general liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$500,000, holding the city harmless for any personal injury or property damage resulting from the existence or operation of the sidewalk café. The license must be renewed annually.

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) no longer allows sidewalk cafés on state-owned right-of-way free of charge. FDOT now requires the City to enter into a lease agreement with the State to manage sidewalk cafés on state-owned right-of-way, assessing a fee of \$2.00 per square feet per year. This fee is in addition to the license fee charged by the City. In addition, the State requires that business owners maintain general liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$2,000,000.

There are currently seven sidewalk cafés along state roads that would be affected by this change with current business owners interested in establishing at least two additional sidewalk cafes at the Wooly event venue and the Pop A Top Corner Store on North Main Street.

RECOMMENDATION The Community Development Committee: 1) hear

a presentation from staff; and 2) recommend that the City Commission authorize an agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation allowing

sidewalk cafes along state roads.

### Gainesville Police Department (GPD) Off-site Improvements (B)
