In order to hire a new Equal Opportunity Director, the City Commission authorized the Human Resources Department to engage the services of an Executive Search Firm to initiate a search to fill the position.

The Mercer Group conducted a search and presented resumes of the most highly qualified candidates to be considered on July 2, 2015. Candidates were interviewed by the City Commission at a Special Meeting on August 26, 2015.
