The City Commission referred this issue to the Audit, Finance and Legislative Committee during their December 5, 2013 meeting.

On January 29, 2014, the Audit, Finance and Legislative Committee met and discussed this item. The Committee received extensive public input focused on numerous issues of concern related to past management practices and business decisions primarily related to the multi-year development and implementation of the Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) between Gainesville Regional Energy Center (GREC), LLC and the City of Gainesville d/b/a Gainesville Regional Utilities (GRU) dated April 29, 2009 and approved by the City Commission on May 7, 2009. There was also considerable discussion regarding the background and financial impact of the "Equitable Adjustment for Change of Law" agreement dated March 16, 2011.

Committee discussions focused on possible actions that could be taken from a management, legal, financial, policy and control perspective to prevent reoccurrence of the actions involved in implementing the GREC PPA and to positively affect the financial outlook of GRU, especially in the area of energy supply and energy delivery.

Committee members agreed to report to the City Commission on February 6, 2014 a joint recommendation for the City to move forward with an external review focusing primarily on GRU past management practices and business decisions related to the implementation and any amendments to the GREC PPA, and including a forward focus on recommendations having positive financial impacts on GRU energy supply and delivery.

150133. Oversight and Accountability of Grants (from the City) (B)

Explanation: On July 2, 2015, the City Commission members directed that the City Auditor's office devise a methodology to determine how recipients of numerous small grants provided by the City have succeeded in their stated mission.

The City Auditor stated that a simple way to follow up on this item would be to include these small entities in the annual internal control plan that will be built into the organizational COSO-based internal control program. At the most recent strategic planning session, the decision was made to implement the COSO-based internal control plan within the context of FY15 Strategic Initiative 4.3: Develop tools/metrics for measuring the economic, environmental, and social sustainability of the City, championed by Mr. Paul Folkers.

The City Auditor and staff met with Mr. Folkers and Mr. Benton to discuss. The City Auditor is including work on this item in the FY16 Audit Plan.

RECOMMENDATION The Audit and Finance Committee review the status of the referral and take appropriate action.

Information on the Unassigned Fund Balance (B)

Explanation: While finalizing the millage rate for property taxes for the fiscal year 2016 budget, the City Commission discussed the projected fund balance amount, the City policy on fund balance (10%), and how the City policy compared to other municipal fund balance policies. The City Auditor followed up on questions by pointing out the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) recommendations (16.67%). The Finance Director is the organizational expert in this area.
