#### 181008. Smart City Update (B)

Explanation: Technology is one of the most powerful social and economic forces of our time. A 'smart city' can leverage emerging technologies to improve quality of life by optimizing the delivery and experience of city services and by improving the relationship between citizens and government.

As a 'New American City', Gainesville will be approached with new technologies and innovations to test, explore and deploy. Our success in supporting a strong economy, fostering greater equity, planning for a better future and becoming a community model depends in part on our readiness to adapt these new technologies to meet the specific needs of our community.

In Fall 2017, Staff provided a general Smart City overview to the Digital Access Subcommittee and the General Policy Committee (Legistar# 170261) and presented a framework for Gainesville's Smart City Program. The fundamental pillars of this framework include infrastructure, workforce development, policy and planning, and economic development. Starting from November 2017, select

representatives from multiple City departments began meeting monthly as the Smart City Working Group to facilitate interdepartmental communication and collaboration on smart initiatives. In Spring 2019, a Smart City Coordinator position was created within the Department of Technology to provide dedicated support and advance Gainesville's smart city objectives.

During this briefing, Staff will provide updates on Gainesville's Smart City program and will highlight on-going and planned community initiatives.
