<u>200551.</u>		Single Use Plastic Accessories Ordinance Options (B)
	Explanation.	On 12/8/2020, Public Works Community Builders presented information about single use plastics in the community to the Zero Waste Subcommittee. At the meeting, the Subcommittee requested information on ordinances and policies to reduce the use of single use accessories.

On 1/19/2021, there was a presentation on what other communities around the country were doing to reduce the use of single use accessories. The Subcommittee requested that Community Builders return with options to address the issue.

Community Builders will present options on ordinance language related to requiring that accessories be available on request only.

A presentation on single use plastics was made by Michael Heimbach, Sustainability Manager. Katherine Mockler, Assistant City Attorney, spoke to the matter concerning single use plastic bags.

MOTION: 1) For staff to draft a policy on green purchasing, including for GRU and general government; 2) draft an ordinance and policies regarding plastics in public places, city spaces and events; 3) research requiring recycling services for polystyrene and plastic bags in restaurants and venues; 4) research payment on accessory items in restaurants.

Public comment was opened - no one spoke to the item. Tom Strickland, Recycling Coordinator, gave a presentation. Members discussed. David Schwarz, responded.

MOTION: Support recommended Option 1 (from the presentation). Set target date for an ordinance as January 2022. Request more information on single-use plastics banned by the EU and Canada; and what can the City legally do regarding those items.

Public comment was opened - no one spoke to the item.

A presentation on glitter and plastic confetti was given by Tom Strickland, Recycling Coordinator.

MOTION: Staff draft an ordinance on a ban of plastic confetti and balloon releases, working with the City Attorney's Office on enforcement.
