Precinct 38	Precinct 38 expands into the City and will be mostly a city precinct.
Precinci 38	Precinci 38 expands into the city and will be mostly a city precinci.
Precinct 45 and 51	Precinct 45 and 51 will no longer be a Gainesville City Precinct.
Precinct 37	Precinct 37 has doubled in size to the north - Legislative lines surround it on three sides. To reduce the population in 37, Precinct 61 will expand north.
Precinct 57,21, 17	Precinct 57 has now moved east and follows legislative line on the west. Because of difficult choices that had to be made, Precincts 21, 17, 50 population will now be evened out among the three precincts. The border for 17 has moved north straight across 39 th Avenue.
Precinct 7	Precinct 7 moved slightly west across 13 th St. and has been cut in half in size at 16th Avenue. Population is similar in size.
Precinct 5 & 25	Precinct 5 & 25 is now split by the new legislative lines. Precinct 25 is slightly reduced in size on the west and south side. Precinct 5 now cuts off on the west at NW 22 nd St.
Precinct 5	Precinct 5 has expanded east. A hard line on the west side of Precinct 5 was drawn to even out population between Precinct 5 and Precinct 26. Precinct 5 and 26 are now bordered by NW 22 nd St.
Precinct 19	Precinct 19 remained virtually unchanged. We followed the legislative line up to northwest. It has increased population.
Precinct 59	Precinct 59 is split in two by the legislative and senate lines. The precinct is so populous that it created a new Precinct to the south. It will be designated as precinct 40, as that precinct will be eliminated.
Precinct 23 & 44	Precinct 23 will exclusively be a city precinct. We have added some of the population from Precinct 44 on the southwest side.
Precinct 31	Now bordered by the legislative lines to the south, includes area surrounding the UF Natural Area Teaching Lab in the southwest
Precinct 44	Reduced in size on the southeast to add population to precinct 23
Precinct 54	May expand south into County to include complete census block south of Williston Rd.
Precinct 39	We took some of the population from Precinct 39 to evenly distribute population in Precincts 39, 36 and 32. Precincts 32 and 39 now meets at the legislative border (32 South and 39 north).
Precinct 36	The legislative line splits Precinct 36 as it existed in half. We moved Precinct 36 to the west to the borer of I75 west and SW 62 nd Street on the east side.

City of Gainesville Tentative Precinct Changes

Precinct 32	Expands south along the legislative border, now includes the portion of the city north of W. Newberry Rd. that includes the area around North Fl. Regional Med. Ctr.
22 and 24	24 expanded west and 22 expanded south to completely absorb old precinct 40. The number will be used for the new precinct south of precinct 59.
Precinct 40	Absorbed into 24 and 22 to eliminate a split
Precinct 50	Has slightly reduced in size to the north, but expanded to the east to NW 16 th Terrace, and west past 34 th St. to include the neighborhoods surrounding the Gainesville Baptist Church.
