PRCA- Will inherit the Boulware Springs Facility O&M costs from GRU starting in FY23. The MOU is in process now but will outline the ownership of the building by GRU, but all operation, maintenance and renewal upgrades will be the responsibility of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs. MOU will be reviewed with the City Manager and then City Commission before finalized. The historic O&M costs for this facility have been approximately \$30,000 per year (per Tony Cunningham email 2/7/22). PRCA is being told to expect to take over these annuals costs beginning Oct 1, 2022 for the FY23 budget -forward.
