A Resolution of the City Commission of the City of Gainesville. Florida. authorizing the filing application(s) with the United States Department of Transportation and the Florida Department of Transportation, for grants funded by Department of Transportation or by FFY 2022 apportionments (or federal funds made available from prior federal fiscal year apportionments) under the Federal Transit Act of 1964, as amended, and authorizing the Interim City Manager or her authorized designee to execute any such applications and to otherwise act on behalf of the City of Gainesville, Florida, in connection therewith.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation and the Federal Secretary of Transportation are authorized to make grants for transit projects; and

WHEREAS, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the applicant, including the provision by it of the local share of the project costs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:

- 1. The Interim City Manager or her authorized designee is authorized to execute and file applications on behalf of the City of Gainesville, Florida, with the United States Department of Transportation and the Florida Department of Transportation for grants funded by FFY2022 apportionments (or federal funds made available from prior federal fiscal year apportionments) to aid in the financing of capital and operating assistance projects pursuant to the Federal Transit Act of 1964, as amended.
- 2. The Interim City Manager or her authorized designee is authorized to execute and file with such applications and agreements, any assurances or any other documents required by the United States Department of Transportation and the Florida Department of Transportation.
- 3. The Interim City Manager or her authorized designee is authorized to execute any other related documents and take any other actions necessary in connection with the resulting grant agreement on behalf of the City of Gainesville, Florida, Regional Transit System, with the United States Department of Transportation and the Florida Department of Transportation.
- 4. The Interim City Manager or her authorized designee is authorized to sign requests for Contract Time Extension(s), as may be required in support of the project.
- 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
