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City of Gainesville Fellowship Program Background

- Result of the UF and City establishing an MOU to formalize an institutional partnership
 - Goal of partnership was to align strategic plans and improve community engagement
 - The press release can be seen here
- Started in 2017 with the Bob Graham Center and City Manager's office
 - Program's aim was to empowering civic-minded students
- City fellows hired in the Office of Strategic Initiatives for digital services, research and prototyping, engagement and visual design



City of Gainesville Fellowship Program Overview

- Multiple positions are open within three City departments – SPI, City Clerk, and GFR
 - Fellows are assigned a mentor from their respective departments to assess progress
- Fellows focus on project-based work addressing City issues and working to meet strategic goals



- Fellows work 15-20 hours per week through the fall and spring semester
- Fellows will be paid according to the pay plan set for the Intern Job Classification by HR, with the minimum being the current living wage rate, and a progression-based pay plan according to the student's academic year
- Students from all majors are welcome to apply


Fellowship Application

- Describe skills and experience related to the position
- Describe what one hopes to gain from the Fellowship
- Provide example of involvement in serving the greater Gainesville community
- Submit a current resume and letter of recommendation from a professor, job supervisor, or academic advisor
- Additional requirements from the Bob Graham Center
 - A minimum of 3.0 GPA
 - Preference to students in junior or senior standing

Fellowship through the Bob Graham Center at UF



- The City Fellowship page on the Bob Graham Center (BGC) website can be seen <u>here</u>
- Positions are posted and advertised through the BGC in March
 - Staff are invited to speak at an info session while the application is open to answer questions of interested students
- BGC sends Staff the list of vetted applicants w/ supporting documents
- Staff review applications, schedule interviews with appropriate panel, and make Fellow selections in late spring
- Selected students are required to register for one fellowship credit hour during the fall and spring semester
 - A progress report must be submitted to the BGC by the student at the end of each semester



Fellowship at Santa Fe College

- Partnership started in 2021
- Positions are posted and advertised through the Division of Student Life in March
 - The press release can be viewed <u>here</u>
- Student Life staff sends Staff the list of vetted applicants w/ supporting documents
- Staff review materials and request student availability for interviews
- Staff review applications, schedule interviews with appropriate panel of City Staff, and make Fellow selections in late spring

• Course-based Partnerships


- Staff have partnered with faculty and students at several colleges/universities and our local school system to advance projects that can benefit from the research, ideation, and prototyping of students.
- Volunteer Toolkit
 - Students from Engage Florida are working on a set of toolkits to better equip students to participate in meaningful community engagement and to support nonprofit organizations as they bring on volunteers.

- Food-Generating Business Survey
 - Interested students were trained to conduct the survey with businesses in the community to gain insights into food waste diversion practices.

• <u>Partnership for</u> <u>Reimagining Gainesville</u>

 Students with a passion for community development are welcome to get involved with ongoing projects or volunteer to assist with operations.

Examples of Other City Internship Programs



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Information Technology (IT)

Ironwood.

• IT typically has service desk interns from Santa Fe College, who work 30 hours/week. Interns are typically paid, and positions are advertised through the city website, but a partnership between Santa Fe and the City is being created to facilitate recruitment.

PCRA typically has 2-3 unpaid interns who work ~25 hours/month.

Positions are available for administration, recreation, nature, and

Cultural Affairs typically has multiple unpaid interns each semester

• There are also intern opportunities within IT Operations, typically for students pursuing bachelor degrees.

Gainesville Regional Utilities Water/Wastewater

Parks, Recreation, and Cultural Affairs (PCRA)

 Typically has 5-6 paid internship positions which are posted and advertised through HR. Applications are shared with UF, and interns must be studying either civil or environmental engineering. Interns typically work 15-20 hours a week, and assist with environmental regulatory projects, design projects, data collection, analysis, and more.


