1: Project Background



Project Background



 November 2021: The City partnered with BerryDunn to assist with updating the master fee schedules for the Department of Sustainable Development Building and Planning Divisions.



 November 2021 – May 2022: BerryDunn met on multiple occasions with City staff and stakeholders, updated the the cost-of-service analysis, and developed updated fee schedules forecasted to satisfy the revenue requirements for the Department.



 May 2022: BerryDunn compiled all staff and stakeholder feedback, financial and operational analysis methodologies, and findings and recommendations into a final project report.



• June 2022: BerryDunn presenting findings and recommendation to the City Commission for consideration and acceptance.



Summary of Findings – Building Division





• Revenue: \$4,048,462

• Expense: **\$4,761,354**

Cost Recovery: 85.0%

Revenue to 100% cost recovery:\$713,000

Fund Balance (FY 2021): \$2,813,860
 (Fund Balance Ceiling: \$3,449,888)



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Summary of Findings – Building Division



- 72.0% of annual revenue is generated from the fees and charges listed above.
- Additional revenue generation projected to be \$433,120 annually.
- The second largest revenue generating service area is building plan review and fire plan review, fees will remain unchanged.









• Revenue: **\$249,148**

• Expense: **\$2,260,063**

Cost Recovery: 11.0%

Revenue to 15% cost recovery:
 \$125,000 - \$150,000



Summary of Findings – Planning Division



- Proposing 23 of the 58 current fees and charges be adjusted.
- Related to Land Use, Subdivisions, and Zoning services. Currently these services account for 89.0% of annual revenue generation.
- Additional revenue generation projected to be \$125,000 \$150,000 annually.
- Cost recovery ceiling projected to be 20.0% based on current service delivery structure.







• Seven new Planning Division fees proposed for consideration.

3: Fee Level Updates & Projections



Proposed Fee Adjustment Considerations



- Cost Recovery Rates: Cost recovery rates for projected fee scenarios:
 - Building Division baseline: 85.0%. Projected to increase to 94.0% 100+% annually with a 15.0% increase.
 - Planning Division baseline: 11.0%. Projected to increase to 13.0% 15.0% annually with a 15% increase.
- **New Planning Fees:** Projected to have minimal impact on revenue generation, but would establish fees for services currently being provided.
- Annual Fee Updates: The Department should review all fees and charges annually and consider adjustments as needed.
