

## RESOLUTION 211185

**A Resolution of the City Commission of the City of Gainesville, Florida, authorizing the City Manager to execute the agreement modification of the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management-Alachua County Emergency Management, State Hurricane Shelter Retrofit Grant Agreement between the City of Gainesville, State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management and Alachua County Emergency Management to receive additional funding for Hurricane Shelter Retrofit grant funding for the Grace Marketplace Center Project.**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management and Alachua County Emergency Management executed Resolution No. 200999 on April 15, 2021, the State Hurricane Shelter Retrofit Grant Agreement by the City, the contract for financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the City;and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management and Alachua County Emergency Management requires the City Commission to adopt a resolution authorizing the acceptance additional grant funds.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, FLORIDA:**

1. That the City Manager or authorized designee is authorized to accept the modification to the agreement from the State Hurricane Shelter Retrofit (SR) Grant Funding from the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management and Alachua County Emergency Management for the Grace Marketplace Center Retrofit Project.
2. That the City Manager or authorized designee is authorized to execute modification to the agreement from the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management and Alachua County Emergency Management Grant Agreement including any supplemental agreements for the purpose of Scope Changes and/or funding adjustments, as well as execute Assurances, Certifications, and all other documents as may be required in support of the project.
3. That the City Manager or authorized designee is authorized to sign grant agreement modification to accept additional grant funds, as may be required in support of the project.
4. That the City Manager or authorized designee, within the City's approved budget, is authorized to provide the local share to match such grant funds as may be required.
5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
