Where We Are Now

The GCRA Reinvestment Roadmap identified Community Partnership Grants under its Community Enhancements & Housing Initiatives. If approved, this Program will fulfill this goal.

PRCA has in place the Special Event Additional Support (SEAS) grant program, an in-kind grant for City services available to 501(c)3 organizations.

Proposed Updates

- Implemented feedback from the Board to allow for non-allocated funds to roll over into following application cycle
- Simplified the qualification methodology
- Prepared the application to also function upon City approval as the Agreement document pending City signatures
- Added in section 6 to allow for de minimus (minor) corrections to be approved by the City Manager

SEAS Grant

Special Event Additional Support (SEAS) grant program for Fiscal Year 2023 opened for applications on March 1. Grant period is October 1, 2022 – September 30, 2023.

Depending on funding use, the grant may be reopened mid-year for additional applications.

In-kind services can include:

- Safety: GPD and/or GFR security, traffic and EMT
- Traffic Services: signs, barricades
- Parks Personnel: staffing, clean-up
- Waste: Garbage/Recycling bins, trash pick-up
