2 3 4 5 6 7 8	An ordinance of the City of Gainesville, Florida, to vacate, abandon, and close certain portions of a public right-of-way located in the 200 block of NW 1 st Avenue, as more specifically described in this ordinance; providing directions to the City Clerk; providing a severability clause; providing a repealing clause; and providing an effective date.
9	WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 30-3.41 of the City of Gainesville's Land Development Code
10	(Chapter 30 of the City of Gainesville Code of Ordinances), an application was initiated by the
11	owner(s) of land abutting the subject public right-of-way requesting the City to vacate,
12	abandon, and close the right-of-way; and
13	WHEREAS, the request to vacate the subject public right-of-way was presented to and
14	approved by the appropriate departments of the City of Gainesville; and
15	WHEREAS, the City Plan Board, which acts pursuant to the authority granted in Section 4.02 of
16	the Charter Laws of the City of Gainesville and which acts as the Local Planning Agency
17	pursuant to Section 163.3174, Florida Statutes, held a public hearing on January 27, 2022, and
18	voted to recommend that the City Commission approve this vacation of public right-of-way;
19	and
20	WHEREAS, at least 10 days' notice has been given once by publication in a newspaper of
21	general circulation notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of public hearings to be
22	held by the City Commission of the City of Gainesville; and
23	WHEREAS, public hearings were held pursuant to the notice described above at which hearings
24	the parties in interest and all others had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard; and
25	WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that the vacation of the subject right-of-way meets the
26	required criteria in Policy 10.2.1 of the Transportation Mobility Element of the Comprehensive

1 Plan and Section 30-3.41 of the Land Development Code.

2 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE,

- 3 **FLORIDA:**
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The following described public right-of-way is hereby vacated, abandoned, and
- 5 closed for use by the public generally:

6 See public right-of-way labelled as "Alley 20 Feet Wide" shown on the Replat of the 7 West Half of Lot 19 of BRUSH'S ADDITION TO GAINESVILLE, recorded in Plat Book "A", 8 Page 16 of the Public Records of Alachua County, Florida, attached as **Exhibit A** and 9 made a part hereof as if set forth in full. The location of the property is shown on 10 **Exhibit B** for visual reference. In the event of conflict or inconsistency, **Exhibit A** will 11 prevail over **Exhibit B**.

13 **SECTION 2.** The City reserves unto itself, its successors, and assigns a public and private

14 utilities easement over, under, across, and through the property described in Section 1 of this

15 ordinance for the purpose of installing, maintaining, and operating public and private utilities

- 16 including stormwater management.
- 17 **SECTION 3.** The City Clerk or designee is authorized to record a true copy of this ordinance
- 18 in the public records of Alachua County, Florida.

19 **SECTION 4.** If any word, phrase, clause, paragraph, section, or provision of this ordinance or

20 the application hereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional, such

- 21 finding will not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given
- 22 effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application, and to this end the
- 23 provisions of this ordinance are declared severable.

24 SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of

25 such conflict hereby repealed.






Figure 1: Zoning




Figure 2: Land Use


